A Special Holiday Travel Insurance Scheme is available for all passengers travelling on our holidays which is arranged with ETI - International Travel Protection (the UK branch of Europäische Reiseversicherung AG) who are licensed by the Bundesanstalt Für Finanzdienstleistungsaufsicht (Bafin - www.bafin.de) and approved by the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA - www.fca.org.uk) to undertake insurance business in the UK. Should you wish to take advantage of our Holiday Travel Insurance please include the appropriate premium when booking your holiday.

DEMANDS AND NEEDS - This insurance policy will suit the Demands and Needs of an individual or group (where applicable) who have no excluded pre-existing medical conditions, are travelling in countries included within the policy terms and who wish to insure themselves against unforeseen events detailed in the cover section below. Subject to the terms, conditions and maximum specified claim limits.

IMPORTANT - We will not provide you with advice about the suitability of this product for your individual needs but will be happy to provide you with factual information. We summarise below the details of the insurance cover provided which also includes Speciality Assistance Ltd - 24 hour emergency service. The following is a brief summary of the cover available. Full details of cover, policy, warranties and exclusions will be forwarded with our confirmation of booking. In any event you may ask for a specimen copy of the Policy Wording before booking.

POLICY EXCESSES - Cancellation & Abandonment £50.00 for holidays of 3 days or more. Property excess £250. There are excess figures that may be payable that are confirmed in the terms and conditions.

Your policy will provide cover Cancellation, Emergency Medical Expenses and Curtailment due to an existing medical condition provided that at the time of taking out the insurance and at any time prior to travel you are able to confirm that:

- 1) You are not aware of any reason why you may have to cancel or cut short the planned trip.
- 2) If you any medical condition which has been previously diagnosed, investigated or treated in any way in the last 12 months you have:
 - not had to consult a doctor about your condition (other than for a planned check up).
 - not had your medication changed due to exacerbation or instability of your condition.
 - not been told you are terminally ill (unlikely to live for longer than six months).
 - you are not currently receiving or awaiting treatment for any illness or injury as a hospital day case or in patient.
 - If you received medical treatment for any illness or injury as a hospital day case or in-patient within the 6 months prior to booking the trip that you have consulted with your Registered General Practitioner regarding your ability to participate in the planned trip and had your records noted accordingly.
 - you are not travelling for the purpose of obtaining medical treatment abroad.
 - you are not currently residing in a nursing home.

Please note that there is no cover for claims arising directly or indirectly from a known existing medical condition of non travelling close relatives or close business associate or any recognised complication caused by the known existing medical condition.

If your health or your on going medication changes between the date the policy was bought and the date of travel you must advise Travel Administration Facilities on 0203 8293885 8am - 8pm Monday - Friday, 9am - 5pm Saturdays, as soon as possible. The insurer will advise you of what cover they are able to provide, after the date of diagnosis. The insurer reserves the right to increase the premium, increase the excess, exclude the condition or withdraw the cover should the stability of the condition make it necessary.

General Exclusions: If you or anyone else named on this policy has not been a resident in the UK for the past 6 months this policy cannot cover you.

In addition to the above, the policy also contains the following main exclusions:

- Participation in any hazardous activities unless the appropriate additional premium has been paid.
- Your suicide, self-injury or any wilful act of self-exposure to danger (except where it is to save human life)
- Manual Labour
- You travelling on a motorised vehicle for which you do not hold the appropriate qualifications to ride in the UK or the Channel Islands.

COOLING OFF PERIOD - You should read your policy immediately to ensure it meets with your requirements. If for any reason it does not it must be returned to the issuer of the policy within 14 days of the date of issue or prior to travel whichever ever is the sooner. Your money will be refunded in full, provided no claims have been made or incident likely to give rise to a claim has arisen. If you cancel your policy after 14 days no refund will be given.

Your Financial Security

In order to comply with package tour regulations and to protect clients pre-payments, all monies paid are held in a secure clients account and are controlled by independent persons. In accordance with EC directives, funds would be available to cover refunds and repatriation in the unlikely event that we should cease to trade, thus giving you complete security and peace of mind.

Bookings - A non refundable deposit of £25 per person will secure your reservation. The balance is due at least 28 days prior to departure. We reserve the right to cancel any booking and retain the deposit if the full balance is not received by the due date. Single supplements are charged at the discretion of the hotel. Any special requests will be noted at the time of booking, and will be passed on to the hotel. Although we cannot guarantee to fulfil every request we will do our best to accommodate them.

Seat numbers will be issued with bookings on a first come first serve basis. It may be necessary to adjust seating arrangements but this will be avoided as far as possible.

Cancellations - All deposits are non refundable. Cancellations must be confirmed in writing. If a cancellation occurs within 28 days of departure the following charges apply:

Prior to 28 days	deposit only

Fuel Costs - Due to the current climate, prices may increase due to fuel costs which will be totally out of our control. We will however, endeavour to keep all our customers informed and up to date on this situation.

Complaints - Should you have a complaint please inform your driver as soon as possible, he will do his best to solve any issues within his control. If the matter cannot be rectified complaints should be made in writing within seven days of the return of your tour to the head office.






